SWC Youth Singles Tournament Rules 2018

IT IS EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO READ, UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES

GENERAL:

1. All bowlers must be current members of the USBC with a 2017/2018 season USBC membership card or proof that one has been applied for
2. Bowlers must be currently bowling in a USBC youth league in a Suburban Windy City USBC membership center. A list of qualified Suburban Windy City USBC centers can be found at www.swcbowl.com/bowling-centers
3. Bowlers must check in at least one half hour ahead of scheduled time and present their current USBC membership card
4. Divisions will be as follows for both boys and girls: U12, U15, U20 and an optional all ages scratch
5. Handicap will be 95% of 220 with 3 games being bowled.
6. **Entrants in the tournament shall use the higher of:**
 - a. **Highest sanctioned league average of 21 games or more from the 2016- 2017 season.**
 - b. **If no previous average, entrant shall use the highest current sanctioned league average as of and including Saturday, February 3rd, with a minimum of 12 games. If this is used, a copy of the bowler's league sheet MUST be provided, showing the bowlers total pins and games with an average.**
 - c. **If none of the above apply, the bowler will enter as scratch.**
7. No entry fee will be refunded after a bowler has been scheduled.
8. In case of disability/injury after a game has started, unfinished frames/games will be scored with a zero.
9. Bowlers may bowl as often as they like with a paid entry for each squad, but may only cash once
10. Paid late bowlers will be allowed to bowl, but starting at the current frame and receiving zero for the frames missed.
11. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by a check for the total fees as listed on the entry form. Make checks payable to **Suburban Windy City USBC** and must be received on or before February 3rd. Any entries received after that date will be treated as a walk in entry and subject to a \$5 late registration fee and lane availability.
12. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:5 ratio in each division
13. Walk in's permitted as space allows and are subject to an additional \$5 late entry fee. Walk in bowlers must check in one half hour ahead of a scheduled squad time

DRESS CODE (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

1. Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the appropriate attire, worn tattered or faded clothing is not considered suitable

Examples of acceptable attire: Collared shirts, mock-turtle necks, USBC/Bowling center sponsored jerseys, Dress or khaki slacks and jeans.

*Examples of **prohibited** attire include but are not limited to: Yoga Pants, Head wear (hats etc.), shorts, T-Shirts, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc. workout attire and bib overalls. CLOTHING ADVERTISING TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR OBSCENE GESTURES OR OBSCENE PICTURES IS PROHIBITED*

2. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee decision will be final. For questions on appropriate attire, contact the SWC Office or tournament management on site
3. The use of any electronic device is prohibited during competition

RULES

1. Each entrant will check in at least one half hour ahead of their scheduled time.
2. All participants must wear bowling shoes. Use of **any** foreign substance on the surface of the lanes, such as talcum powder will not be permitted.
3. Only competitors and tournament officials shall be allowed in the settee area during practice and competition. No coaching of the bowlers will be allowed during tournament competition.
4. Bowlers are not permitted to eat or drink in the player's area while participating in the tournament. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed at the lanes during the competition.
5. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the bowling center. Individuals are subject to removal for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward other persons with no refund of entry fee
6. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament manager immediately. All score corrections must be made by a tournament official. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament manager and any committee members present. Score changes will be checked by the Tournament Committee. A correction not initialed by a Tournament Official will not be allowed resulting in a zero score for the game in question
7. Any appeal or protest shall, in all cases, be made in writing to the tournament manager and shall be submitted no later than 24 hours after the game has been bowled. Entrant must state grounds for the appeal or protest and all pertinent information. The action of the tournament officials shall be final.
8. This tournament is certified by the Suburban Windy City USBC and shall be governed by the rules of the USBC.
