9-Pin No-Tap Mixed Doubles Tournament Rules

1. This is a doubles tournament only.
2. This is a no-tap tournament. Entrants will receive a strike if 9 pins are knocked down on the first ball in the frame.
3. One member of each team must be a woman. She does not need to be a member of The Suburban Women's 600 Club.
4. The tournament shall be conducted on a scratch basis. Approximately 1 entry in 6 will cash. Additional prize(s) will be available for bowlers with a combined team average lower than 340.
5. The tournament will not be certified, but USBC certified averages will be used in order to determine if a team qualifies for the under-340 team average prize. Entrant shall use his/her highest USBC certified league average as of the end of the previous season, including summer averages, provided he/she had bowled 21 games or more. If no previous average, an entrant shall use his/her highest current USBC certified league average as of, and including Sunday, January 21, 2018. (If the latter is used, a copy of bowler's sheet must be provided.) **If a bowler bowls in a league that is not sanctioned, a final average sheet and/or current standing sheet (for new bowlers) from that league can be used to verify averages for the under-340 average team prize.**
6. Each bowler will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. All main prize money will be paid based on scratch scores. In the event of ties, prizes for the positions will be pooled and divided equally.
7. The tournament will start on schedule and tardy bowlers will begin bowling and their score counted in the frame being bowled. No bowler will be permitted to "catch up" the frames they have missed by being late.
8. Entry fees must be returned with entry form. Any entries that are not prepaid prior to the day of the tournament must be paid in cash.
9. Entry fees shall not be refunded.
10. All prize money will be returned 100%. All prizes will be paid out approximately 30 minutes after the end of the tournament
11. Tournament officials reserve the right to extend competition, and to reject any entry.
