IT IS EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO READ, UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES

1. Athletes under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present for the duration of the event. All athletes shall abide by the rules and conditions of this event. Athletes/parents/Guardians release the sponsoring organizations, and each of them, and their respective officers, members, employees, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all liability for any injury to person or damage to or loss of property which an athlete may sustain, or which a parent or guardian may sustain as a result thereof or directly, during or as result of an athlete's participation in the tournament.
2. This tournament is open to Youth USBC members of Suburban Windy City USBC and is USBC certified.
3. Entrants must use this years highest certified league average, or composite average of 21 games or more as of 12/1/24. If no average this year, they can use the highest certified league average from 2023-2024 with 21 games or more. If using the current league average, a copy of the bowler's individual average page or current standing sheet must accompany the entry form. League members with no established average will be given a 220 average. If any average is from a Sport League (also known as Tough Shot and PBA Experience), Challenge, or established on sport patterns, tough shots, international patterns, whether the league is certified or not, it must be reported and will be adjusted as per the USBC conversion chart. Use of this average for entry may be denied.
4. If you bowl a strike on the first ball you get the strike, if you get a nine count on your first ball you get a strike. If you get an eight count or less on your first ball, you will bowl your second ball. This is a scratch tournament.
5. All games are bowled on the same lanes.
6. Youth bowlers will have all prize winnings deposited into their SMART account.
7. All USBC tournament rules will apply.
8. Awards will be given out in a 1 to 3 ratio.
9. Any bowler arriving late will be allowed to bowl and their score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled on their scheduled pair of lanes.
10. In case of disability/injury after a game has started, unfinished frames/games will be scored with a zero.
11. Prepaid late bowlers will be allowed to bowl but starting at the current frame and receiving zero for the frames missed
12. Walk ins permitted as space allows.
13. Only competitors and tournament officials shall be allowed in the settee area during practice and competition.
14. No coaching of bowlers will be allowed during tournament competition.
15. Bowlers are not permitted to eat or drink in the player's area while participating in the tournament. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed at the lanes during the competition.
The use of any electronic device in the bowler's area is prohibited during competition.
16. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament manager immediately. All score corrections must be made or approved by a tournament official.
17. Any appeal or protest shall, in all cases, be made in writing to the tournament manager and shall be submitted no later than 24 hours after the game has been bowled. Entrants must state grounds for the appeal or protest and all pertinent information. The action of the tournament officials shall be final.

DRESS CODE (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgement when selecting attire. worn tattered or faded clothing is not considered suitable.

The following attire is PROHIBITED: Hats, shorts, CLOTHING ADVERTISING TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OBSCENE GESTURES OR OBSCENE PICTURES IS PROHIBITED. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament manager or designee. Decisions will be final. Questions about appropriate attire may be directed to the SWC Office or tournament management on site.
