# SWC Youth Singles Tournament Rules 2025

### IT IS EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO READ, UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES

Athletes under the age of 18 are under the governance of their parent/guardian for the duration of the event. All athletes shall abide by the rules and conditions for the 2025 Youth Singles Tournament. Athletes/parents/Guardians release the sponsoring organizations, and each of them, and their respective officers, members, employees, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all liability for any injury to person or damage to or loss of property which an athlete may sustain, or which a parent/guardian may sustain as a result thereof or directly, during or as result of an athlete's participation in the tournament

- 1. This tournament is certified by Suburban Windy City USBC and governed by the rules of USBC
- 2. All bowlers must be currently bowling in a USBC league certified by Suburban Windy USBC and must present their 2024-25 USBC membership card at check in. If card is not yet received, proof that one has been applied for must be presented at check in.
- 3. Divisions will be based on average as follows for both boys and girls: Under 120, 120-149, 150-179 and 180 and over.
- 4. Entrants in the tournament shall use the *higher* of:
  - a. The highest current sanctioned league average as of and including Sunday, February 16, with a minimum of 21 games. A copy of the bowler's league sheet MUST be included with entry, showing the bowlers total pins and games and average.
  - b. OR, if higher than above, the highest sanctioned league average of 21 games or more from the 2023-2024 season
  - c. If none of the above applies, the bowler will enter as scratch.
- 5. Handicap will be 95% of 220 with 3 games being bowled.
- 6. In case of disability/injury after a game has started, unfinished frames/games will be scored with a zero.
- 7. Pre-Paid late bowlers will be allowed to bowl but starting at the current frame and receiving zero for the frames missed.
- 8. Walk ins permitted as space allows. Walk in entries close 30 minutes prior to squad time
- 9. Only competitors and tournament officials shall be allowed in the settee area during practice and competition. No coaching of bowlers will be allowed during tournament competition.
- 10. Bowlers are not permitted to eat or drink in the player's area while participating in the tournament. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed at the lanes during the competition.
- 11. The use of any electronic device in the bowler's area is prohibited during competition
- 12. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament manager immediately. All score corrections must be made or approved by a tournament official.
- 13. Any appeal or protest shall, in all cases, be made in writing to the tournament manager and shall be submitted no later than 24 hours after the game has been bowled. Entrant must state grounds for the appeal or protest and all pertinent information. The action of the tournament officials shall be final.

# DRESS CODE (STRICTLY ENFORCED):

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgement when selecting attire, worn tattered or faded clothing is not considered suitable. Dress or khaki shorts may be worn.

The following attire is PROHIBITED: Hats, gym shorts, sweat pants, CLOTHING ADVERTISING TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OBSCENE GESTURES OR OBSCENE PICTURES IS PROHIBITED. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament manager or designee. Decisions will be final. Questions about appropriate attire may be directed to the SWC Office or tournament management on site.
